GAMBLING (LICENCE VARIATION) REGULATIONS 2026

Údarás Rialála Cearrbhachais na hÉireann (the Gambling Regulatory Authority of Ireland), in exercise of the powers conferred on it by sections 9 and 38 of the Gambling Regulation Act 2024 (No. 35 of 2024), with the consent of the Minister for Justice, Home Affairs and Migration, hereby makes the following regulations:

Citation

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Gambling (Licence Variation) Regulations 2026.

Commencement

2. These Regulations come into operation on XXXX 2026.

Interpretation

3. (1) In these Regulations, “Act of 2024” means the Gambling Regulation Act 2024 (No. 35 of 2024).

(2) A word or expression that is used in these Regulations and is also used in the Act of 2024 shall have in these Regulations the same meaning as it has in that Act unless the contrary intention appears.

Fees for applications to vary licence

4. (1) The fee payable on the making of an application by a licensee of a betting licence under section 117(3)(a) of the Act of 2024 to vary the event, series of events or class of events in respect of which the licensee has been licensed to provide pool betting is €1,250.

(2) The fee payable on the making of an application by a licensee of a betting licence under section 117(3)(b) of the Act of 2024 to provide pool betting for an event, series of events or class of events where the licensee did not, at the time the licensee applied for the licence, wish to provide pool betting is 25% of the fee that was payable in respect of the application for the grant of that licence under the Gambling (Licence Application Fees) Regulations 2026 (excluding from that calculation any fee that was payable under regulation 4(1)(b)(ii) of those Regulations).
